Solomon Dedicates the Temple

2 Chronicles 6:12-42

- ¹² Then Solomon <u>stood before the altar of the LORD</u> in front of the whole assembly of Israel and spread out his hands.
- ¹⁴ He said: "O LORD, God of Israel, <u>there is no God like you</u> in heaven or on earth--you who keep your covenant of love with your servants <u>who continue wholeheartedly in your way</u>.
- ¹⁹ Yet give attention to <u>your servant's prayer</u> and his plea <u>for mercy</u>, O LORD my God. Hear the cry and the prayer that <u>your servant</u> is praying in your presence.
- ²⁴ "When your people Israel have been defeated by an enemy <u>because they have sinned</u> <u>against you</u> and when they <u>turn back and confess your name</u>, praying and making supplication before you in this temple.
- ²⁶ "When the heavens are <u>shut up and there is no rain</u> because your people have <u>sinned against</u> <u>you</u>, and <u>when they pray</u> toward this place and confess your name and <u>turn from their sin</u> <u>because you have afflicted them,</u>
- ²⁹ and when a <u>prayer or plea is made by any of your people</u> Israel each one <u>aware of his</u> <u>afflictions and pains</u>, and spreading out his hands toward this temple—
- ³⁰ then hear from heaven, your dwelling place. Forgive, and deal with each man according to all he does, since you know his heart (for you alone know the hearts of men),

³³ then hear from heaven, your dwelling place, and do <u>whatever the foreigner asks of you</u>, so that all the peoples of the earth may know <u>your name and fear you</u>, as do your own people Israel, and may know that this house I have built bears your Name.
