HOW DO WE GET DISCOURAGED?

- I. When we focus on the <u>DELAYS</u>
- > Our response: Manipulation
- II. When we focus on the DOUBTS
 - Our response: Abandonment

HOW DO I DEFEAT DISCOURAGEMENT?

1) **PROTECT YOUR POSTURE**

a. Maintain Your Position

So, my dear brothers and sisters, be strong and immovable. Always work enthusiastically for the Lord, for you know that nothing you do for the Lord is ever useless. 1 Corinthians 15:58 (NLT)

Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:6-7 (NIV)

b. Maintain Your Peace

You keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on you, because he trusts in you. Isaiah 26:3 (ESV)

Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—<u>think about such things</u>. ...<u>And the God of peace will be with you</u>. Philippians 4:8-9 (NIV)

2) PRACTICE PATIENCE
