WATCH YOUR MOUTH! My Words Matter! – Part 2 James 3:1-12 (NIV) CrossWord Christian Church

"We all stumble in many ways. If anyone is never at fault in what he says, he is a perfect man, able to keep his whole body in check." James 3:2 (NIV)

"Death and life are in the power of the tongue...." Proverbs 18:21a (NKJV)

I. WHY MUST I WATCH WHAT I SAY? 3 Reasons:

1. MY TONGUE DETERMINES WHERE I GO. (vs. 3-4)

"When we put bits in the mouths of horses ...we can <u>turn</u> the whole animal." (vs. 3)

"Or take ships as an example. Although they are so large and are driven by strong winds, they are steered by a very small rudder wherever the pilot wants to go." (vs. 4)

2. MY TONGUE CAN DESTROY WHAT I HAVE. (vs. 5-8)

(vs. 5) "Consider what a great forest is <u>set on fire</u> by a small spark. (vs. 6) The tongue is also a fire ..."

"... it sets the <u>whole course</u> of his life on fire, and is itself set on fire <u>by hell.</u>" (vs. 6b)

3. MY TONGUE REVEALS WHO I AM. (vs. 9-12) It's unpredictable.

Sometimes it (the tongue) <u>praises</u> our heavenly Father, and sometimes it breaks out into curses against men who are made like God. vs. 9 (TLB)

"Out of the same mouth come <u>praise and cursing</u>. My brothers, <u>this should not be</u>." (vs. 10)

"Can both fresh water and salt water flow <u>from the same spring</u>? ... can a fig tree bear olives or a grapevine bear figs? Neither can a salt spring produce <u>fresh water</u>" (vs. 11-12)

THE PROBLEM: <u>I HAVE A HEART PROBLEM!</u>

"But the words you speak <u>come from the heart</u>—that's what defiles you. For from the heart come <u>evil thoughts</u>, murder, adultery, all sexual immorality, theft, lying, and slander." Matthew 15:18-19 (NLT)

II. WHAT'S THE SOLUTION?

1. GET A NEW HEART.

"<u>Rid yourself</u> of all the offenses you have committed and <u>get a new heart and a new spirit!</u>" Ezekiel 18:31a (NIV)

2. ASK GOD FOR HELP EVERYDAY.

"Set a guard over <u>my mouth</u>, O Lord; <u>keep watch</u> over the door of my lips." Psalm 141:3 (NIV)

3. THINK BEFORE YOU SPEAK.

"...Everyone should be quick to listen, <u>slow to speak</u>, and slow to become angry." James 1:19b (NIV)

"What you say can <u>preserve life or destroy it</u>; so you must accept the <u>consequences of your</u> <u>words</u>." Proverbs 18:21 (TEV)
