When I respect God’s name, it brings peace into my life because...

I. I Recognize That God Can Meet ALL MY NEEDS.

God’s Names Tell Me:

(Jehovah Shalom) “*God is my Peace.*” Judges 6:24

- God wants to **reduce my stress in life**.

“Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.” John 14:27 (NIV)

(Jehovah Tsidkenu) “*God is my Righteousness.*” Jeremiah 23:6

- God wants to **make my life right**. (Good) (The Walls Group)

(Jehovah Rophe) “*God is my Healer.*” Exodus 15:26

- God wants to **heal me when I am hurting**. (Heal my mind, Lord!)

“Let Your compassion quickly meet our needs...” Psalm 79:8b (NLT)

“And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.”
Philippians 4:19 (NIV)

II. I Recognize That God Is Greater Than MY BIGGEST PROBLEM.

“His name is greater than all others...” Psalm 148:13 (TEV)

“Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised, and His greatness is unsearchable”
Psalm 145:3 (ESV)

III. I Recognize That God Wants Me To Be In HIS FAMILY!

“You are members of God's very own family...” Ephesians 2:19b (TLB)

- God gave me our church name: We are “CrossWord Christian Church!”

Why is our church name so important?

- Because of The “Cross” of Calvary, and the “Word” of God.
