- God is not looking for the best or the brightest, but the faithful.
- God will ask you to do something that doesn't make sense to see if you are faithful.

1. Your Faith Must Be Bigger Than Your Feelings

¹⁷ If that is the case, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and He will deliver us from your hand, O king. ¹⁸ But if not, let it be known to you, O king, that we do not serve your gods, nor will we worship the gold image which you have set up. Daniel 3:17–18 (NKJV)

- We will never walk in the fullness of God if we do not understand the faithfulness of God.

God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord. 1 Corinthians 1:9 (NKJV)

- Biblical faithfulness is not wishful thinking. It's not "I hope this works out."
- The faithful person looks at the same circumstances everyone else sees and remains faithful.

2. Are You a Faithful and Wise Servant?

Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering, for He is faithful that promised. Hebrews 10:23 (NKJV)
